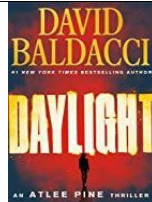


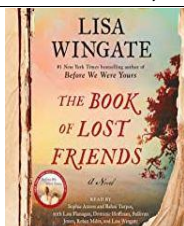
Keep Sharp : how to build a better brain at any age by Sanjay Gupta, MD (BCD)

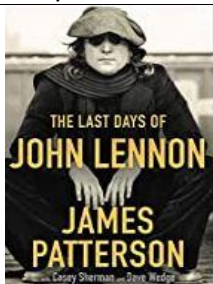
The Book of Lost Friends: a Novel by Lisa Wingate (BCD)

The Last Days of John Lennon by James Patterson and Casey Sherman (BCD)

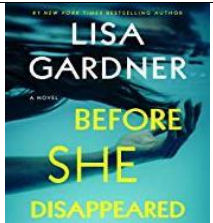

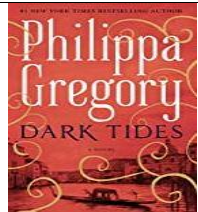
Clanlands by Sam Heughan (BCD)

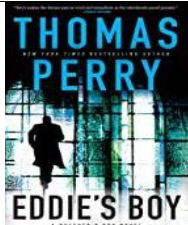
Before She Disappeared by Lisa Gardner (BCD)
